Independent Sexual Violence Advisors

ISVAs are victim focused support workers and advocates who work with victims of sexual violence to enable them to access the services they need in the aftermath of the trauma they have experienced.

The support provided by an ISVA will vary depending on the needs of the victim and their particular circumstances.

The fundamental role of an ISVA includes ensuring that victims of sexual violence past or present have the best possible practical advice on what other services are available to them.

The ISVA can also provide impartial guidance on the processes involved in reporting a crime to the police, and on taking their case through the criminal justice system, should they choose to do so.
